What a right old trek it is to get here – but then the glory is yours. This is a completely romantic and newly restored 13th-century hideout, with wonderful vaulted ceilings, stashed away in the citrus groves and vineyards of the Peloponnese. It's cosy, chic and wonderfully pretty. Hike in the hills of Monemvasia and lunch on fresh octopus at waterside tavernas; then there are hammams and outside hot-tubs, roaring fires, homemade cakes and lots of mountain tea back at the hotel. Kinsterna is so peaceful, quiet, restorative and thoughtful: suck up the lavender eye masks, the underfloor heating in the bathrooms and the privacy of the huge white bed-sized loungers around the pool. Breakfast is a real cracker – champagne, waffles, eggs, wild mushrooms, home-cured bacon and every type of sticky-honey-nutty pastry. Theo, the manager, is utterly charming. Switch off and be spoilt.
